Since the establishment in 2001, more than 700 students have graduated successfully with Master's and PhD Degrees. Post –Graduate Programs Offered

Mater of Laws Degree Program

1. In-depth Study of International Law & International Business Law

With the rapid pace of change in the global society, we inevitably have shifted our focus to international legal knowledge, instead of restricting our interests to domestic law. TLBU Graduate School of Law in Seoul will provide intensive lectures on International Law and International Business Law. Lectures on International Law will include field studies in International Organizations, where students can actually experience the operational system of International Organization.

2. Dual Master of Laws Degree Program (2+1)

This program is offered only in English in partnership with Temple University Law School in the US. Students will sit for classes at TLBU in Korea for two years and continue their studies abroad earning dual master's degrees, Master of Laws Degree conferred by TLBU and LL.M Degree from Temple University. To successfully receive the dual degree, the students must submit their Dissertation at the end of 3 years of studies.



Master of Laws Program in details

Admissions for Master of Laws Program

- Because of our expectation of outstanding scholarship, TLBU is very selective in accepting candidates to the program and only applicants with exemplary credentials are considered. Admission is based upon the applicant's academic qualifications, scholarly potential, dissertation topic, and personal virtue and character.

1+1 Program in the US

- In partnership with Temple University Law School and Drexel Law School in the US, after one year of intensive training in English by the staff at TLBU, students are admitted into the LLM Program offered by the US Law schools. The students are required to be residence for one year and enrolled for the 3rd year at TLBU while studying for LLM Degree in the US. The students are required to submit their dissertations before the 3rd year to be granted Master's Degree at TLBU.
- Students eligible for 1+1 Dual Degree Program have special grant offered by Temple Law School and TLBU in US may offer loans to the students for study in the US.

2 Year Master of Laws Program in the Korea

- Students wishing for study for 2 years for Mater of Laws program will receive intensive training from well qualified teaching staff at TLBU in Korea

Qualification for Admission

English Proficiency

- The applicant should have at least 550 Paper-based TOEFL (PBT), 213 Computer-based TOEFL (CBT), 80 Internet-based TOEFL (IBT), band 5.5 IELTS scores.

Prerequisite Legal Education

For Spring Admissions

Applicants for Masters program must have received, or expected to receive by the end of February of 2026, a bachelor's or master's degree (or equivalent degree) in law or related subjects from an approved institution.

For Fall Admissions

Applicants for Masters program must have received, or expected to receive by the end of August of 2025, a bachelor's or master's degree (or equivalent degree) in law or related subjects from an approved institution.

A final transcript confirming your graduation should be submitted as soon as it is available. We reserve the right to review for reconsideration or revoke the offer of admission if you fail to graduate with your class.

I. Student Management

1. Mentoring
